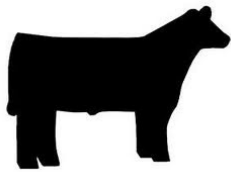

Swine-State Fair validation deadline is June 30 for barrows, cost is \$30

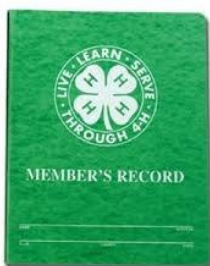
