IMPACTS

- A audience of over 150,000 listened to 7 crop and livestock management updates by radio
- producers attending the Wheatheart Wheat Conference reported a \$254,000 economic benefit of participating in the conference.
- 76 youth and adults attended a 4H information and enrollment cookout

4-H & Youth Development:

- ▶ 4H Cook Out and Recruitment Event— Project and enrollment information was presented to 76 attendees
- Youth Board Meeting—Program review and development meeting to plan educational events to address youth issues in the county. 8 Youth and 4 adults attended.
- ▶ 4 youth and 3 adults attended a poultry project meeting on how to prepare bantams for show. A county bantam show was held during the 4H Cookout and recruitment event.
- ▶ 4H Ambassadors were busy promoting 4H during August. 3 were interviewed by KEYE Radio and 6 members handed out recruitment and enrollment flyers to over 500 people at the Wheatheart Celebration Parade.
- ▶ The 4H Parents Association held one meeting. Officers were elected, the Awards system was reviewed, they audited the bank account and approved a budget plus a fundraising plan.
- ► The 4H Ambassadors met. Officers were elected and members made plans for the annual Awards Celebration
- The Ag and Livestock Club met. The program was focused on Livestock Nutrition and feeding. Officers were elected and trained and future programs were planned.
- ➤ The Alamo 4H Club met. Officers were elected and trained. Future programs were planned.
- ➤ The 4H Archery Task force met. Two leaders agreed to lead archery programs beginning twice a month starting in October. One leader agreed to go to training to get certified in archery instruction in November

59% of the producers completing surveys, reported at 20% or higher knowledge increase in the following subject areas: Wheat Market Outlook, Wheat Variety Selection, Cattle Management on Wheat Pasture

68% of the producers completing surveys reported an average economic benefit of \$21,372 per participant

- The Quarterly Ochiltree County Ag News was published and distributed to 300 producers and ag business professionals. The following articles were in this issue: Useful Publications and Websites, Managing Heat Stress in Cow Calf Operations, Wheat Seed Quality Management
- Seven radio interviews were conducted with three different radio outlets providing information related to crop and livestock management conditions. An estimated 150,000 contacts were made through those interviews.
