4-H & Youth Development:

- The annual Ochiltree County Junior Livestock Show was conducted. A total of 45 4H members exhibited 25 hogs, 5 sheep, 12 goats, 7 heifers and 11 steers. Average prize premiums for each member was \$5911.
- One workshop was conducted to teach 4H members exhibiting livestock, grooming and showmanship, A total of 22 youth and 8 adults attended.
- The 4H .22 Rifle group met 6 times under the leadership of a certified volunteer. 8 members was the average attendance.
- The 4H Archery group met 6
 times under the leadership
 of a certified volunteer. 7
 members was the average attendance
- 3 monthly 4H Newsletters were published and distributed to the members, parents and volunteers containing project and activity information. Results of past events were also shared.
- The 4H Learn to Sew project met 3 times with 5 members attending each time. Basic sewing skills were taught at each meeting.
