Archery meetings are scheduled on Tuesday's. Please watch for communications if you already participate.

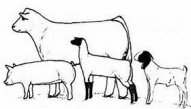


Horsemanship Meeting:

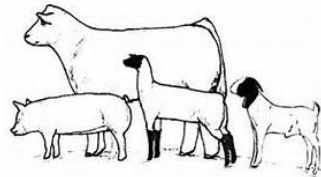


County Show Checks & Thank You's


